It's easier than ever to find first-quality news on the Internet.

The New York Times offers excerpts and complete texts of major articles every day. The full texts are organized by category at <http://www.nytimes.com>.

The NY TimesFAX publication is available in Adobe Acrobat PDF at <http://www.nytimesfax.com/times.pdf>. Viewing this requires the Adobe Acrobat reader software, which is available for free from DGL's website at <http://www.dgl.com/tebklist.html>.

If you're a more independent user, <http://crayon.net> allows the creation of a custom newspaper using over 230 major news sources.

The resulting document, including hyper-text links, can be saved to your computer's hard disk, retrieved daily, and the current news will always be available.

There's no shortage of useful news sites, even <http://www.yahoo.com> has direct links to Reuters online news service.

Win95 Tips

Here are a few tips and tricks that may help you use Windows 95 more effectively.

1. When rebooting your system, click Start, Shut Down, Restart the Computer. Then depress the <shift> key while clicking the <yes> button.

This will restart Windows 95 without requiring a complete hardware warm boot. It can save a couple of minutes.

2. Hide the task bar to gain a few extra pixels of real estate on your screen by clicking Start, Settings, Task Bar, Auto Hide, OK.

If you want to see your taskbar, move your mouse to the area of the screen in which the taskbar was previously visible. It will slowly appear, ready for use.

3. Use Win95 as your access point to the Internet or as a link between your home and office.

Windows 95 has great networking features built right into the operating system.

By using the Microsoft Plus! pack for Win95, multiple computers can concurrently dial-in to an office computer to access corporate data on the PC or network - be sure to use password protection to prevent unauthorized access.

Win95's TCP/IP and Internet dialup abilities aren't matched in any other software package. There's every reason, especially performance, to use Win95's Internet connection at home and work.
