Intranet Publishing

The hot topic this season is "intranets." Similar to the **Internet**, **intranets** allow text, graphics, audio, and video to be transmitted from a host computer to the client computer on your desktop.

The difference: an intranet is within your company.

Intranets allow employee manuals, morning news, memoranda, and other internal correspondence to be instantly available to all employees.

Most new word processors can convert documents to HTML (HyperText Markup Language) or PDF (Adobe Acrobat Portable Document Format). These formats can be easily posted to a company's intranet server. Once there, every employee has access to the information, without the possibility of altering the text.

We're evaluating some very low cost webserver programs. These are designed to run an Internet server; however, they work equally well on internal networks.

Even without these servers, HTML allows links to files that are stored on a standard network file server.

There's no reason to send paper anymore.

Access97 & Web Data

Microsoft's Access97, the database management application of the Office97 suite, will allow Access users to post databases to Microsoft's Internet Information Server.

The databases may be shared across the Web and queried through standard Web browsers.

Currently, Access users may export database table information to HTML, the standard language of the Web. This new technology will allow Access data to be queried and updated live via the Web.

This is a unique opportunity for Web developers who don't have a background in SQL (Structured Query Language), which now offers similar features.

Office97 Web wizards (automated helper applications) will make it easier to publish database information on intranets as well as the Internet.

Instant Internet 32-Bit Apps

Instant Internet, the secure LAN-to-Internet connection system now allows 32-bit winsock applications.
