Free Frozen Apps

Symantec has released "Norton CrashGuard" that allows frozen 16- and 32-bit applications to be released without requiring an immediate reboot of the system.

It's available for free until March 1, 1997 at their Internet website: <http://www.symantec.com/crashguard/>.

Notepad - New Text Editor

If you often use Windows' Notepad, Write, or WordPad, you will appreciate the new features in Notepad--yes, there is an "s" in the program's name.

It's available for free at <http://www.bremercorp.com/>. It allows up to 10 files to be edited concurrently, and includes a "recent files" list as well as menu options to edit your config.sys, autoexec.bat files, and win.ini files.

Wire Your LAN to the 'Net

One of the most difficult tasks that businesses face is how to economically share access to the Internet for all users of a local area network.

We've found Instant Internet is the easiest way to connect up to 50 PC users of any local area network to a single dialup connection.

So, rather than installing multiple modems and phone lines, a single phone line connection can be shared. And, if you need the extra bandwidth, ISDN and other digital connections may be used.

HTML/Email Virus

Last year the good times virus, which announced that a virus could be sent via email, was correctly dismissed as a hoax; but not before raising quite a ruckus across the Internet.

But, now there is a true HTML virus that can affect users of not only web browsers but also email clients.

We learned of a recent posting on CompuServe Information Service that teaches how to create a virus that forces web browsers to retrieve data from internal hardware devices such as communication and printer ports. This code can cause the browsing workstation to hang or lockup, thus requiring a reboot of the computer system.

Netscape Navigator and other email clients now allow HTML commands to be viewed within an email message; the offending commands can now affect the system via email.
